**PROSPECTIVE BIDDERS, READ THIS SECTION CAREFULLY**

- (b) Land use laws and regulations applicable to the property;
- (c) Approved uses for the property;
- (d) Limits on farming or forest practices on the property;
- (e) Rights of neighboring property owners; and
- (f) Environmental laws and regulations that affect the property.

**Conditions of Sale:** All potential bidders are subject to inspection of funds prior to or during participation in the auction to qualify as a bidder. Individuals without proof of sufficient funds, or that have not qualified before the start of the auction; will not be allowed to participate. Only U.S. currency

**and/or cashier's checks made payable to Coos County Sheriff Office will be accepted. Payment must be made in full immediately upon conclusion of the sale. Only the judgment creditor who obtained the writ may credit bid up to the Writ amount plus allowable costs. The judgment creditor must have cash in hand for any difference above the amount of the Writ and allowable costs.**


