NOTICE OF SHERIFF'S SALE (Real Property)

On April 17, 2018, at the hour of 10:00 AM at the Jackson County Sheriff's Office, Civil Division, 5179 Crater Lake Hwy, in the City of Central Point, Oregon, I will sell at public auction to the highest bidder for cash or cashier's check, in hand, made out to Jackson County Sheriff's Office, subject to redemption, all of the interest that the Defendant had on or about 7/2/2013, the date of the Deed of Trust, and also the interest that the Defendant had thereafter, in the following described real property:

Commencing at the North quarter corner of Section 29 in Township 36 South, Range 2 West, Willamette Meridian, Jackson County, Oregon; thence South 1097.00 feet to the South line of Merita Terrace; thence South 88°35' West along said line 2673.51 feet to the true point of beginning; thence South 290.00 feet; thence South 88°35' West 280.62 feet; thence North 290.00 feet, more or less, to the South line of Merita Terrace; thence North 88°35' East along the South line of Merita Terrace 280.62 feet to the true point of beginning.

The judgment creditor must have cash in hand for any difference above the amount of the Writ and allowed costs.
